3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Causes burns.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

GENERAL: CAUTION! First Aid personnel must be aware of own risk of burns. Chemical burns must be dealt with immediately, do not delay.

EYES: Promptly wash eyes with plenty of water while lifting the eye lids. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.
